

1,000,000 Minutes Read!

Alki Adventures Day: Friday, March 20th

At Alki, we believe that strong reading skills and a love for reading are essential in preparing our students for success in school and in life. Research tells us that students should be reading at minimum 30 minutes per night. In order to help encourage this, we do this through our Alki Reads program.

What is it?

All Alki students are given a monthly Alki Reads Calendar to record the numbers of minutes they spend reading or are being read to each day. At the end of the month, students add up their minutes and record at the bottom of the page. Our librarian adds up the minutes for the whole school at the end of the month and shares that information with the school. Each student receives a charm for their necklace for each month's calendar that is turned in. We also do a prize drawing at the end of each month for students who turn in their calendars.

Our school goal is to reach 1 million minutes by January and 2 million by June! If we are able to reach these goals, we celebrate by having an Alki Adventures Day!

What is Alki Adventures?

Each Alki staff member creates a fun activity for students grades K-5, students can then select the activity they would like to participate in. Priority

is given to 5th graders first, then 4th, then 3rd, etc. For about 2 hours in the afternoon, all students in the school report to their chosen or assigned activity.
