ALKI GLOBAL READING CHALLENGE

Alki's Global Reading Challenge team, The Devils, had a very good day on Friday, March 16th representing Alki at the semi-finals. We took the shuttle to the water taxi. On the water taxi we were invited into the wheel house by the captain. Once we got to Seattle we had to stop at Top Pot (it happened to be the one President Obama visited) for a treat and pep talk. Next



was a guick walk to the library and then before checking in we took a tour all the way to the top of the library. Once we were all checked in, photos taken and seated the Challenge began. After 24 very hard questions, asking about very specific details of the ten titles students read, our team came in tied for 3rd out of nine schools. Alki's 4th and 5th GRC participants have been reading the ten titles since they were revealed on Nov 1st. Our seven teams of six to seven members faced off in mid-February to determine the team that would represent Alki at the semi-finals. The Devils: Ka'ena, Monroe, Aliya, Nissa, Vincent, Colston and Henry, worked well together during the high stress challenge. They even took part in challenging a guestion that was poorly written. The guestion got thrown out. So proud to see our students speak up when something didn't seem right.

If you have a child who will be in the 4th or 5th grade next year please encourage them to participate in the Global Reading Challenge. Not only will they read great books that transport them around the world, they will learn how to be a member of team, be responsible for reading at least two titles to support the team, make new friends and most importantly have fun.




