LETTER FROM THE PTA PRESIDENT

Welcome to October! The highlight of my September was the Back to School BBQ

hosted by Erin and Erin Kelley. This was their last year hosting this particular event and if you see them please take a moment to express your gratitude to what they've given to our community over the years. They're around through the end of this year which means it's the perfect time for our next Back to School BBQ host to step in and assume the mantle while they are still around to answer questions and share whatever magic makes that event run so well (Erin mentioned they have never been rained out for that event which means they've got something going on!). In this month we meet on the sidewalk for Walk to School Day (Oct 10), enjoy our first day off from school (Oct 12), and give a nod to the Heroes in our life while noshing on donuts before school (Heroes and Donuts, Oct 17). Capes are not required for that last one but as long as they don't stay on for school we aren't discouraging them either:).

Our kids are going to be hearing about Safety & Belonging this month, and about what it means to feel accepted. When I was a kid I thought a lot about what it meant to be accepted by a group, and how I could change myself in order to belong. As I age I see how that intention needs to be flipped on its head - first I need to accept myself for who I am, and then I can find a group who likes me for me. I know it's largely in-one-ear and out-the-other with the things I tell my kids, but I hope it doesn't take them as long as it took me to figure that out. I've seen this sense of belonging modeled again and again by our students - from the girl who held my daughter's hand as they marched in to their first day of kindergarten together, to new kids sprinting around the playground as if they've been in our community all along. I hope we adults are modeling this belonging and acceptance as well as our kids are modeling it for us.


