#### Dear Alki Families,

Our favorite day of the year is just a few weeks away, the Alki-A-Thon! We want to give you a few details about the day, so you know what to expect.

#### What is the Alki-A-Thon?

It is Alki PTA's second-largest fund-raising event (after the auction) and is a run/walk-a-thon. We set up a course around the Alki playfield and the students run, walk, skip, or dance around the course as many times as they can, earning pledges for each lap (or a flat pledge for the effort!) The event is held during the regular school day (Friday, May 31st) from 12:30 – 2:00PM. Students go back to their classes after the event for regular dismissal. Students are not required to participate.

#### Volunteers needed!

We can't make this event happen without a lot of volunteer support: setting up the course, donating and cutting up oranges, helping the teachers get the students ready, helping to tally laps, etc. You can volunteer for 30 minutes or for the whole day – it's up to you! But we can guarantee that you will have fun and connect with your Alki community. - SIGN UP TO PLEDGE ONLINE Fixed pledges can be made by credit card quickly and securely by visiting <u>https://tinyurl.com/alkiathon2019</u>. Donors enter their information and their pledge amount, the NAME, TEACHER and GRADE of the student(s) they are sponsoring and receive an emailed receipt. Please note: donors cannot "pledge per lap" online, flat pledges only. Please track ALL your donors/pledges on the form provided as there will not be a way to view individual pledge totals via the website. Pledges may also be made via cash or check made out to Alki PTA (checks preferred over cash.)
- 2. **PAPER PLEDGE FORM** Using the paper pledge form, each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge per lap, (and maximum pledge) OR a flat pledge, and their method of payment so students can keep a record of all sponsors and pledges collected on their behalf (even those made online.) For cash/check donations, students may collect the pledges in advance but must keep the payments until all are collected and ready to be turned in.
- 3. **COMPANY MATCHING** Please encourage your donors to inquire if they have company matching through their employer and to submit their Alki-a-Thon receipt to their workplace to double their donation! Please note: participants may not ask for pledges from any Alki Elementary or Alki Community Center Staff.
- 4. **DONATING TO WEST SEATTLE SCHOOLS** If you would like to participate, please write a separate check directly to the school(s) you wish to support and Alki PTA will happily deliver the donations to their school representative.
- 5. **DAY OF ALKI-A-THON** On the day of the Alki-a-Thon, each class will walk, run and/or jog for a specified time period on the Alki playfield. Each lap is approximately 1/6 mile. Volunteers will track each lap by marking the back of the students' t-shirts in a designated "race bib" area. After the Alki-A-Thon, volunteers will be tallying the laps completed for the individual and class totals. Use your student's t-shirt to determine their total number of laps to calculate pledges.
- UPON COMPLETION OF THE ALKI-A-THON Students will bring home their results for outstanding pledge collection. Please return pledge sheets and donations to school by Friday, June 7th to be counted toward individual and classroom awards. All donations must be received by the last day of school, Friday, June 27th.
- 7. **REMINDERS** Walking, running or jogging will be allowed. Participants are encouraged to wear tennis shoes, hats and sunscreen if it's sunny or rain gear if it's rainy. Participation is not required and rest areas will be provided for those needing a rest or for those who aren't participating. Additionally, a first aid station, water station and field monitors will be on-site for the safety of our students.

All students receive an event t-shirt and necklace chain with 1 "foot" per every six laps completed (If you have your necklace and foot charms from previous Alki-a-Thons – please wear it on the big day!)

## FUN STUFF!!!

After all pledge packets are returned by **Friday June 7th** there will be an awards assembly the following week announcing the classrooms with "Most Spirit," "Most Pledge Participation" and "Most Laps" for grade level and individual runners. Together, let's make this the most fun Alki-A-Thon yet! Alki-A-Thon day has a long-standing tradition of also being "**Crazy Hair Day**" Feel free to braid, paint, curl, and spike your locks into fun and freaky fashions to help get in the spirit to run, walk and skip for Alki!
