

This includes the school's efforts to ensure equity in discipline, learning and opportunity for all students.

Mission Statement: The Alki school community shares responsibility to ensure that each student achieves academically, socially and emotionally.

The more specific responsibilities of the BLT are to oversee the facilitation and development of:

- Continuous School Improvement Plan (CSIP). 1.
- 2. Schoolwide professional development plan to support the CSIP.
- 3. School's yearly budget.
- 4. Yearly review of the Decision-making Matrix.

Alki BLT meets on the second Monday of each month at 2:35 PM. Alki staff, families, and community members are invited to observe meetings of the BLT. Members of the community are invited to participate in the decision-making matrix as At-Large Parent Representatives (invited through the At-Large Nomination Process). This year Mel Spiker is serving as the PTA's Parent Representative, and will

be sharing meeting summaries in Alki Currents. Reports to the community will be presented at PTA meetings as well.

Next BLT Meeting is Monday, October 14 (2:35 - 3:35 PM) in the Alki Library

The BLT met in August for a summer retreat. Scope and topics included detailed plans for Alki's all-school assemblies, best practices for reducing the risk of exposure to food allergens, Seattle Public School's Strategic Plan, and Alki's Professional Development Plan PDP). Alki's PDP aligns with Seattle Public School's Strategic Plan and focuses on high quality instruction and learning experiences in Science and Arts Integration, includes Positive Behavior Intervention Supports, and highlights development of Inclusive & Authentic Engagement Strategies. Medication at School

An Authorization to Administer Medications at School form must be completed each year for medication your student will/may need at school and school camps. This includes all prescription and over-the-counter medications and remedies (Ibuprofen, Tylenol, anti-itch cream, etc.). An authorization form is also required for students to self-carry and self-administer any medications at school. This form can be found at the school office or the Seattle Public Schools website at: https://www.seattleschools.org/departments/health_services/forms/

Immunizations

Being fully immunized is important to keep all our students and staff safe and healthy. Some immunizations are required for continued attendance at school. Students may be excluded if their immunizations are not up to date. Seattle Public Schools uses the Washington state Immunization Information System (WAIIS) to track a student's compliance. Why PTA Matters

Did you know many decisions that impact children's education are not made by educators, or in their schools? These decisions frequently come from district, state or federal officials. According to the 2014 U.S. census, there are 114,991,725 households in the United States, but only 33,763,140 contain children of school age (age 3-18). This means that less than 30% of U.S. households have children in school, and over 70% do not.

When issues affecting children and schools are discussed, families with children need to join forces with teachers and school administrators to be heard, as there is a good chance that the people making the decisions (politicians, school board members, community leaders, etc.) do not live with children, nor have vested interest in play.

Who PTA Serves

PTA is the oldest and largest child advocacy association in America, comprised of over 24,000 local PTAs and 4 million members. As part of this nationwide network, parents have a voice in decisions that impact children in their individual schools, and at the district, state and national levels.




