



LETTER PRINCIPAL DEESE

Aloha Alki Families,
October's character trait is Safety & Belonging. This is such an important month because keeping children safe and helping them to feel like they belong is our most important job here at school.



At Alki, we believe that social emotional learning is just as important as academics. In your child's classroom, they are doing social emotional learning using the RULER curriculum from Yale University. In this curriculum, students will learn the 4 anchor tools: Class Charter, Mood Meter, Meta Moment, and Blueprint. These tools will help our students to understand their emotions, work through conflict, and manage stress and anxiety.

You can partner with us in this work by using these tools at home. Visit here (<https://www.seattleschools.org/academics/curriculum/ruler>) to learn about them! We will also have a RULER table at Curriculum Night (Oct 17) where you can learn to use these tools at home and take a RULER kit with you!

Even as adults, when our minds are stressed or we are worried, we are often closed off to learning something new. In an effort to be **"always learning, and always growing"** I am making a commitment to model self-care and to use these anchor tools myself in front of students. I love the ability to use this common language with children and these tools really work!

We look forward to seeing you at Curriculum Night on October 17th!

West Seattle Food Bank - Ongoing Food Drive

Starting this month, Alki will have a bin for food donations that will go to the West Seattle Food Bank. Our first graders chose to support the WSFB as a part of their community



service, and to support their social studies standards of learning the wants versus the needs of families around the world.

West Seattle Food Bank has a Backpack Program which includes a list of nonperishable food items that are given specifically to children. The Backpack Program provided school children at risk of hunger over the weekend with 9,716 packs of six kid-friendly meals weekly in 2018.

We invite all families to participate in the year long Food Drive at any time, but to make things a bit easier to remember we have a schedule that you can put in your calendar.

December 1st-December 20th: All Grades!!!!






7 REASONS TO VOLUNTEER

There are no tasks too small, and every little bit helps to make the school better. And I have a feeling you'll have a lot of fun along the way.

1. Volunteering Makes a Difference in your Child's Education

Children's whose parents are involved in their schools do better. Research has shown that children of parents who volunteer make better grades and perform better on tests. They're also better behaved, have better attendance, and are more likely to graduate and continue their education.

Taking things off the plate of teachers, administration, and staff frees them up to do what they do best—educate our children.

6. Volunteering Allows You to Use Your Strengths

Volunteering is a great way to showcase your strengths. Look for opportunities that are within your wheelhouse. Using the skills that come naturally to you makes things easier (and often more enjoyable).
