Alki PTA Budget - Fund Shifting




THE CENTED LEWIT FUND

At the February member meeting we discussed a new line item in our budget that "fund shifts" \$5000 of Alik PTA dollars to the West Seattle Public School Equity Fund (wspsequityfund.org). This line item had been approved by membership last spring and this fall, but due to questions that arose, the board proceeded with some fact finding and discussions. Last month the PTA Board recently welcomed a guest speaker to provide clarity around this program and how it aims to 'shift a portion of individual schools' budgets to be distributed as a community resource through a pooled fund" benefiting 5 West Seattle schools with significantly lower fundraising income than Alki and other WS schools in our immediate vicinity. The information gathered was brought to the February member meeting and a motion was made to vote on it again. It was approved by the majority so the board will now proceed with donating these funds to the West Seattle Equity Fund who will distribute the funds to the \$5 school PTAs.
